Our Lady of Mt Carmel is seeking a teacher for our Middle to Upper Primary class. This is a full-time temporary position commencing 1st January, 2022 to 31st December, 2022, with the possibility of on-going employment.

Our Lady of Mount Carmel is a thriving rural school and caters for approximately 60 students (numbers vary from year to year) from Kindergarten to Year Six, with three composite classes, along with small class sizes. The school is well resourced with a 1:1 iPad program, laptops, apple TV's and BenQ Boards in each classroom. We have a dedicated, professional staff who are a cohesive team of educators with a strong focus on our Culture of Care and Culture of Learning.

As we are situated in the Mid-West region, 96km from the City of Geraldton, assistance with re-location is included, and teacher housing is available, with appointment to Mullewa. Please refer to the Teacher Housing and Remote Area Package available through Catholic Education.
